

# Application Note: Compatibility of Power-One Inverters and Tigo Energy Module Maximizers

As concerns Power-One inverter and the Tigo Energy Module Maximizer: if all of the of system components of any photovoltaic system design fall within the manufacturers' stated operating range, Tigo Energy Maximizers do not void the warranty of Power-One inverters. Operating ranges of Power-One inverters are specified in applicable data sheets and installation manuals.

Warranty claims are contingent on the following:

- 1) Maximum photovoltaic system voltage does not exceed the maximum input voltage of the inverter.
- 2) Power-One assumes no responsibility for compliance to EMC regulations for the complete system.
- 3) Power-One assumes no responsibility for the total energy yield achieved as the MPP tracking is performed at the panel rather than the inverter with a Tigo Energy Maximizer.
- 4) Power-One products have been approved by Tigo to operate with the Tigo Energy Maximizer within the operating range of all specified system components.
